

UPOA BRODY YOUNG SCHOLARSHIP

The UPOA Charitable Foundation has established the “Brody Young Scholarship”. The following individuals are eligible:

- 1) Active and in good standing members of the UPOA who have sustained a serious injury in the line of duty, OR
- 2) The immediate family of an active and in good standing member of UPOA who has been seriously injured or killed in the line of duty. Family members include: spouse, children (any natural, illegitimate, adopted, or stepchild less than 25 years of age), parents, siblings, fiancé, and/or significant others identified by the family or known to the UPOA.

An Active Member of UPOA is: Any member of UPOA who is an employee of a police or law enforcement agency who meets the following statutory definition;

U.C.A 53-13-102 Peace Officer Classifications.

1. law enforcement officers
2. corrections officers
3. special function officers
4. federal

- In good standing is: A dues paying member of UPOA who is current on dues at the time of his/her injury or death.

- A Serious Injury is: Any injury that creates or causes serious permanent disfigurement, protracted loss or impairment of the function of any bodily member or organ, or creates a substantial risk of death.

All eligible candidates must meet the following requirements order to be selected to receive the scholarship:

1. Applicants may be a high school senior or be enrolled as students at a college, university, trade, or business school. Students beginning school must have received a letter of acceptance from the eligible college, university, trade, or business school. Graduate students are not eligible for scholarships.
2. Applicants must be a resident student of the State of Utah.

Each application will be reviewed for completeness and approved by the scholarship committee. All applications will be accompanied by:

- 1) A transcript of high school credits and/or a transcript of college credits for applicants in institutions of higher learning.
- 2) A letter from applicant with personal, specific facts as to his/her desire to continue his/her education and why financial assistance is requested.
- 3) Three (3) letters of recommendation verifying the application and giving general moral and personal traits (these should be from community leaders, ministers, elected officials, principal, counselor, dean or professor).

The application period will be from March 1 to December 1 of each year. The scholarship winner will be announcement on or about Feb 1. Deadline date for all applications for scholarship will be observed in all instances.

Membership status of applicant will be verified by the UPOA Membership Chairman. The composition of the UPOA Scholarship Committee shall be made up as follows:

- 1) Chairman: This person will be appointed by the President of UPOA and shall have no vote in the selection except to break a tie vote.
- 2) The remainder of the Committee will consist of at least 3 people and be appointed by the Committee Chair.

There shall be no consideration whatsoever given because of friendship, rank of applicant, applicant's parents, or applicant's spouse. Neither shall the applicant's geographical place of residence be considered. Awards will be made on the basis of scholarship, character, leadership and need.

Awards will be sent directly to the recipient with each check made payable to the recipient's choice of school. To receive the awards, verification will be required to the effect that enrollment has commenced.

If the recipient does not complete the school term for which the scholarship is awarded, due to any cause other than sickness or physical injury, the recipient will refund the award to the Utah Peace Officers Association within sixty (60) days from the date enrollment has terminated.
